# 國際中國語言學學會第 21 屆年會 (IACL-21)

- 一、 國際中國語言學學會(International Association of Chinese Linguistics) 第21屆年會將於2013年6月7日至9日在臺灣師範大學召開。誠摯邀請世 界各地從事漢語語言學和中國境內語言研究的學者、學生踴躍參加。
- 二、 準備在會上宣讀論文的學者須提交論文摘要,每位報名者在一篇獨立完成的論文摘要之外最多還可繳交一篇合寫的摘要。請透過網際網路繳交論文摘要,網址是: http://140.122.118.57/iaclsubmit。
- 三、 敬請遵照以下格式來書寫摘要:
  - (1) 摘要的檔案格式須為 WORD 和 PDF。
  - (2) 可用中文或英文書寫。英文:請用 Times New Roman 字體, 12 號字體。 中文:請用標楷體/宋體, 12 號字體。
  - (3) 摘要長度不超過一頁 A4 紙(包含例句與參考書目)。
  - (4) 若有特殊符號與字體,請隨檔提供該符號或字體檔案。
  - (5) 摘要作者須匿名(請同時避免任何可能透露作者身分的內容)。
- 四、 論文摘要請在 2013 年 1 月 15 日前繳交。審核的結果將於 2013 年 2 月 22 日 左右公佈。
- 五、 為獎掖青年學者,促進中國語言學研究的發展,本屆 IACL 年會循例設置"青年學者獎(YSA)"、"橋本萬太郎漢語歷史音韻學獎(MJH)"、及"跨學科研究獎(IRA)"三種獎項,並組織論文競賽。參選資格為:
  - (1) 候選者在 2013 年當年不超過 35 周歲、且職稱在副教授以下(不包括副教授)。
  - (2) 曾經獲得 IACL 往屆年會上述獎項者不得參加本次論文競賽。

- 1. Electronic submissions are encouraged and should be sent to tjl@nccu.edu.tw. Otherwise, send the manuscript in triplicate and a soft copy on disk, to: Editors, Taiwan Journal of Linguistics, Graduate Institute of Linguistics. National Chengchi University, Taipei, Taiwan 116, ROC
- 2. Both Word and PDF files are acceptable. A paper normally should not exceed 40 pages single-spaced. The author(s) of each published paper will receive five copies of the journal issue. A manuscript may follow the style sheet of any established linguistics journal; however, once accepted, an article must then conform strictly to <a href="https://doi.org/10.1007/journal-normal-
- 3. Contributions may be submitted from all countries and are accepted all year round. The language of publication is English. However, manuscripts simultaneously submitted to other publications cannot be accepted.

# Journal of Chinese Language Teaching

#### **Information for contributors**

- 1. *Journal of Chinese Language Teaching* is a professional, refereed, international journal focusing on language acquisition, teaching theories, teaching methods and language structure related to Teaching Chinese as a Second Language. Submissions on empirical studies and digital learning domains are welcome as well. Contributions may be in the form of original research articles or book reviews.
- Journal of Chinese Language Teaching includes four issues per year (March, June, September and December.) Manuscripts written in either Chinese or English will be accepted for review. Manuscripts must be neither previously officially published nor simultaneously submitted elsewhere.
- 3. Each submission must include a cover sheet which contains the following elements: (a) title of the manuscript; (b) complete name(s) of the author(s); (c) title, affiliation, and contact information for each author. A cover sheet is also available at <a href="http://www.wcla.org.tw">http://www.wcla.org.tw</a>.
- 4. As applicable, all submissions should be accompanied by abstracts of within two hundred words, in both English and Chinese. The abstracts should be supplied with five or six key

words.

- 5. Submissions must be typed, using Microsoft Word 6.0 (or later version). Chinese-language manuscripts (typed using the "Unicode" input mode) should be kept to 10,000~20,000 characters. English-language manuscripts should be kept to within 20 single-spaced pages.
- 6. To facilitate the blind review process, the author's name should appear only on the cover sheet, not on the title page; all identifying information should be removed from the body of the paper.
- 7. Please e-mail your articles in both Word document and PDF files to cec01@ms28.hinet.net.
- 8. The author whose articles are published in this journal agree to the following uses of their works:
  - a. The articles can be published either on paper or in digital format.
  - b. The articles can be printed, digitized, reproduced, transmitted on the Internet, downloaded on permits, browsed, sold, or provided for information.
  - c. The articles can be accessed in the database of National Library and other information providers.
  - d. The necessary format alteration of the articles is allowed to meet requirements of the systems.

#### Extension of Submission Deadline to February 28, 2013

- 1. Special Issue on Processing Lexical Tones in Natural Speech International Journal of Computational Linguistics and Chinese Language Processing (IJCLCLP)
- 2. This special issue aims to address questions about how lexical tones are processed by humans and machines in the context of natural, continuous speech. Lexical tones in tone languages have been widely investigated in the fields of linguistics, psycholinguistics, computational linguistics, and language acquisition by applying a wide range of theoretical, empirical, and experimental approaches. As the phonetic representation of lexical tones which are produced in connected speech can differ considerably from that of lexical tones which are produced in isolation, research interests constantly grow in how lexical tones are produced, perceived, and processed in realistic speech data. This special issue aims to bring together methodologies from different research disciplines to extend our understanding of lexical tones used in real speaking situations. We welcome submissions addressing the following issues.
  - a. Modeling lexical tones: Can lexical tones which are produced in natural speech be more accurately described and modeled by quantitative/gradient measures or by categorical systems? Is a hybrid approach possible? In what way can lexical tones be

- represented and analyzed by utilizing spoken corpora?
- b. Human language processing: What role do lexical tones play in the mental lexicon? How are lexical tones produced and perceived by native and non-native language users?
- c. Language acquisition: How are lexical tones acquired by typical developing children, hearing-impaired children, and second language learners? Are the phonological development patterns different from each other?
- d. Speech technology: What kind of information about lexical tones can be integrated into ASR and synthesis systems to improve system performances?
- e. Other research results related to lexical tones in natural speech are also welcome to contribute to this special issue.
- 3. Paper submission deadline: February 28, 2013.

Notification of acceptance: May 31, 2013.

Final paper due: August 31, 2013.

Tentative publication date: December, 2013.

4. All submitted papers should present original research work, which has not been published elsewhere. Submitted manuscripts will be peer-reviewed by at least two independent reviewers. - 3. Manuscripts initially submitted to *Taiwan Journal of TESOL* may follow the style sheet of any established TESOL journal, preferably formatted in MS Word and limited to 8,500 words. Once accepted for publication, however, an article must conform strictly to the Taiwan Journal of TESOL style sheet, which is available at our website: http://140.119.172.17/journal/ESL/index.htm.

#### **Information for contributors**

- 1. The journal CONCENTRIC: STUDIES IN LINGUISTICS is a refereed, international journal published in English by the Department of English, National Taiwan Normal University. From Volume 38 onwards, the issues will appear in May and November. We welcome research papers on all aspects of linguistics all year round. However, for manuscripts to be included in Concentric 38.2, the deadline of submission is July 31, 2012, and for Concentric 39.1, the deadline is January 31, 2013.
- 2. Manuscripts for publication, books for review, review articles, and correspondences relating thereto should be addressed to the Editors of *Concentric: Studies in Linguistics* (Department of English, National Taiwan Normal University, No. 162, Sec. 1, Heping E. Road, Taipei City 10610, Taiwan; <a href="mailto:concentric.ling@deps.ntnu.edu.tw">concentric.ling@deps.ntnu.edu.tw</a>).
- 3. Preferably, articles should be submitted electronically, as e-mail attachment, in Word for Windows and in its PDF version. Other formats are possible; please contact the editors first.
- 4. Authors who are not native speakers of English are urged to have their articles thoroughly proofread by a native speaker prior to submission.
- 5. To facilitate the blind review process, authors' names and affiliations should appear only on a cover sheet, in a separate file, not on the title page.
- 6. Except for inset quotations and footnotes in single space, manuscripts must be typeset in 12-point Times New Roman. Papers should follow the format of the *Language and*

- *LINGUISTICS* (ISSN: 1606-822X) style sheet, and are normally limited to 30 single-spaced pages in length, including a 150-word abstract and some key words.
- 7. The journal will not consider for publication papers being simultaneously submitted elsewhere.
- 8. The author(s) will receive one copy of the journal, fifteen off-prints of the article, and the e-copy of the paper in its PDF version upon publication.
- 9. It is the journal's policy to require assignment of copyright from all authors.
